

Report: Genital Herpes Virus Causes Severe Pelvic Pain in Women; The CBCD Recommends Two Natural HSV Remedies



If toweling off after bathing is uncomfortable, try using a hair dryer. Then put on cotton underwear. Cotton absorbs moisture better than synthetic fabric does." (2)

chronic stress, through too much wear and tear, can ravage the immune system." (See the American Psychological Association from February 23, 2006) (3) This weakening of the immune system can lead to a reactivation of the herpes virus, and an outbreak. As MedicalDaily.com notes, "Stress is known to be associated with reactivation of latent herpes virus." (See MedicalDaily.com, from January 21, 2013) (4)

It is important for women to understand that most drugs against the herpes virus only reduce symptoms by one day. "A meta-analysis of five placebo-controlled and two dose comparison studies evaluated the effect of aciclovir, famciclovir or valaciclovir on symptoms. The meta-analysis showed that oral antiviral therapy decreases the duration and the associated pain of an outbreak by merely one day."
