It would leave the necessary accesses available – the power supply port, the earphones plug-in, but it would allow users to enjoy the touch screen convenience of a tablet, without the worry that a stylus or finger oils might scar the surface of the screen.

The result is Melograno's SUIT™, a protective case unlike any other. It slides over your iPad, like a second skin. It is tough and durable, protecting it from scrapes, scratches nicks and bumps – like any good iPad case. It looks great – and better yet – it works with existing chargers and stands so you don't have to invest in special equipment.
