MIAMI, FL, USA, September 14, 2017 /EINPresswire.com/ -- With more than 6.3 Million people being ordered to evacuate some of the shipments were slowed down. Others just completely stopped all together, but anything that made it out was gouged in pricing. In the

Other shipments were still shipped at much higher rates. Previously scheduled shipments that were quoted at \$1350 went up to over \$4000.
