

Dr. David Durham assumes leadership of American College of Neurocognitive Medicine & American Board of Neuropsychiatry

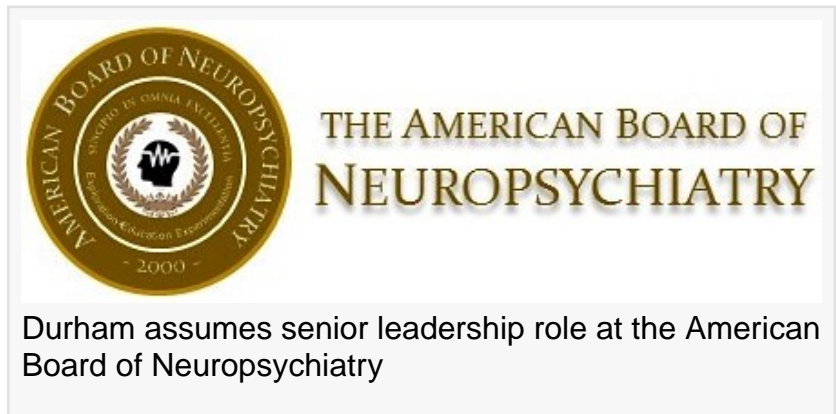
Durham to bring unique skillset to both American College of Neurocognitive Medicine and American Board of Neuropsychiatry
