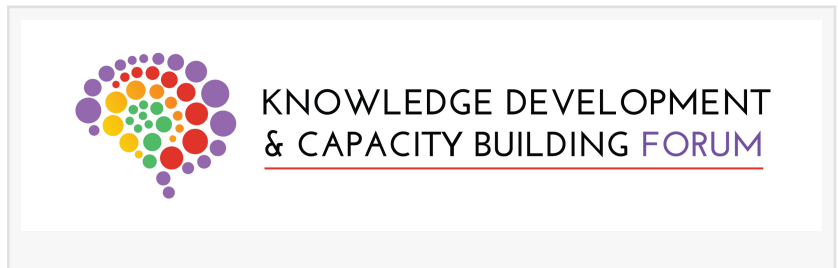


# Abu Dhabi Education Council, Emirates Group, Abu Dhabi Commercial Bank and more to discuss developing national talent
