suspects abuse and neglect of the disabled, including nurses and doctors and all investigators to call Governor Cuomo's abuse hotline immediately, not 911. What is going on is insanity, it is ludicrous, it is wide-scale discrimination against our most vulnerable, it is protecting <u>sexual predators</u> and it is costing many innocent people their lives. Governor Andrew Cuomo cannot continue to get away with steering crimes occurring in his mental health agencies away from 911 and immediate local police assistance.
